

**A BYLAW FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE RESORT VILLAGE
OF MISTUSINNE BEACH AREA AND ITS USERS**

WHEREAS the Resort Village of Mistusinne has been advised that its jurisdictional authority extends to the waters edge;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Resort Village of Mistusinne in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

GENERAL

1. For the beach area extending from the boat launch south to the boundary of Douglas Provincial Park there be:
 - i) subject to Section 2, no motorized vehicles on the beach area
 - ii) no open fires on the beach area
 - iii) no littering on the beach area
 - iv) dogs must be on a leash and restrained from bothering other beach users

EXCEPTIONS

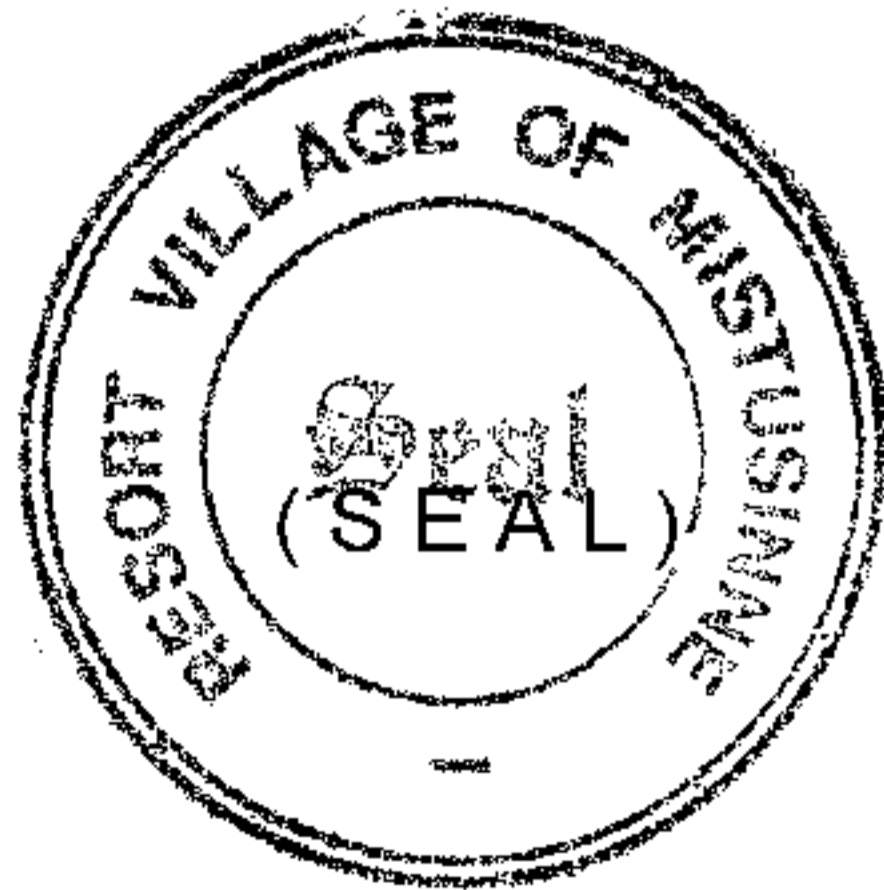
2. For the following circumstances, exemptions will be allowed:
 - i) for a person who needs the use a non-licensed motorized vehicle to access the beach because of a disability. Registration for this free permit is required through the Resort Village Office, and the exemption designation shall be visibly attached to the non-licensed motorized vehicle when it is used for accessibility under this subsection, on the beach.
 - ii) during the period from November 1st to March 31st to accommodate the ice fishing season; and
 - iii) for maintenance vehicles authorized by the Resort Village Council.

PENALTIES

3. A person found guilty of an infraction of a provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the following fine schedule:
 - Section 1(i) – motorized vehicles - \$250
 - Section 1(ii) – open fires - \$100
 - Section 1(iii) – littering - \$100
 - Section 1(iv) – dogs - \$50

REPEAL

4. Bylaw No. 09-07 is hereby repealed.
