Bylaw No. 12-07

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF OVERWEIGHT COMMECIAL VEHICLES ON ROADS WITHIN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF MISTUSINNE

WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Village of Mistusinne deems it desirable to allow but regulate the use of overweight commercial vehicles on roads within the Resort Village limits,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Resort Village of Mistusinne in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- That all overweight commercial vehicles must obtain a permit from the Resort Village of Mistusinne Office prior to entering the Resort Village. The commercial hauler listed on the permit shall ensure that his driver abides by the following:
 - a) to maintain a speed of 25 km/hr or less within the Resort Village limits;
 - b) to utilize slow and careful movements when driving on the paved streets within the Resort Village limits;
 - c) to refrain, when stopped on the paved streets, from turning the wheels of the vehicle;
 - d) access to the rear of lots is only permitted via the paved turn-off points shown in Appendix A; and
 - e) any additional requirements specific to each commercial hauler as stated in the permit.
- Failure to abide by any of the provisions in the permit may result in a fine of \$100 per occurrence.
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its date of adoption.
