Council Meeting Highlights

June 19, 2026, meeting.

Council approved the minutes of our May 15, 2026, regular meeting of council. These are available on our website. The next regular meeting will be held on Friday, July 17 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Office. The office will be closed June 25. We will be open Saturday's from 10 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. starting July 3.

There were no delegates to the meeting.

Edward Stenko presented his verbal report. The Elbow Fire Department was out to tour our operations and be sure that they are ready to facilitate in case of an emergency. We had a Golf Course specialist out to review our course. He advised that our greens are heavily thatched. This will be remedied in the Spring. Our new trees are coming along nicely. We only have a few that do not look healthy, and those ones looked that way upon arrival. Thank you very much to EVERYONE who is assisting with that endeavor. Our tree watering student starts the first week of July! Dripline irrigation will be installed at the top of Hole #1, and along the side of Hole #3, as well as the 600 Loop and Chekepak.

As previously reported our new Zoning Bylaw is being reviewed by the province before being approved. The province has advised that a few corrections are required. Flood specific details must be added. Clarification regarding accessory buildings must be addressed. A rate payer had asked about outdoor showers. There was no mention of this in our documentation either way. Therefore, council felt this was the right time to discuss. Therefore, once these changes have been drafted council will set a date for the public meeting and residents will have the opportunity to review and provide feedback.
