Council Meeting Highlights

March 22, 2026, meeting.

Council approved the minutes of the February 22nd, 2026, regular meeting of council. These are available on our website. The next regular meeting will be held on Sunday, April 19, at 12:00 p.m. at the Municipal Office. Council members may choose to attend electronically, weather dependent. The May meeting will be held Friday, May 15 at 7:00 p.m. Mistusinne Morning will be the next morning (May 16 from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.)

There were no delegates to the meeting.

Edward Stenko presented his verbal report. The tractor is still undergoing repairs. Season start up is underway. All our equipment will be tuned up and ready for spring!

Council passed Bylaw No. 03- 2026, Civic Addressing Bylaw. This Bylaw provides for addressing of homes and other buildings. This Bylaw is available on our website on the Bylaw page. Please have a read.

TREE PLANTING DAY is Sunday, May 31. Council has obtained \$19,000 in Grant Funding to help with the project. Council approved the purchase of 1457 trees. These trees have now been ordered and will be picked up Tree Planting week. WE NEED YOUR HELP planting trees. Please contact the office to sign -up to assist if you are able. The more help we have the more ground we can cover. If you volunteered to help when you completed the annual survey we sincerely thank you. The trees that were listed as problematic on the survey will be assessed this month as we are making the tree removal and planting map.

Council once again discussed the Fire Protection Service Agreement. Administration reached out to more than 40 Resort Villages to determine how other communities address seasonal properties. Approximately 10 responded. The answers were all over the map. Members of council who attend the next fire meeting in Elbow will take this information with them for further discussion.

SAMA Reassessment is underway. SAMA will mail you directly with a form to complete. Please be sure to complete this form and submit it to SAMA. This is the very best way to ensure everything is up to date and current.

Council approved repairs to the Boat Launch at this meeting. 7 - 4'X10' concrete slabs will be ordered from Precon in Saskatoon. TSS Enterprise's from Outlook, will remove the broken pads and replace with the new ones. We hope to have this project completed in Early May, ahead of the season!

BEACH NAMING CONTEST – We have 2 Beaches who need names. The contest will take place at Mistusinne Morning, so bring your creativity and win a prize, besides you deserve a donut.

Council reviewed the proposed Storage Yard Bylaw pertaining to rules regarding usage of storage spots within the lot. Council opted to not complete the First Reading of the Bylaw today. This item has been added to the April meeting agenda for further review.

Mayor Lloyd Montgomery will be attending an MLDP Training session on Strategic, and Financial Planning for Municipalities on April 11 – ahead of the SUMA Convention in Regina.

Council authorized a Deck Permit. If you plan to build this summer, please start early. NEW THIS YEAR – Permit application will happen online. We have had one test of the system so far. While there were a few things to clean up, the process was improved.

Councilor Coutts is looking for entertainers for our August long entertainment. If you have any suggestions, please let us know. The Golf Tournament Committee is looking for volunteers. Please contact our Mayor Lloyd Montgomery if you are interested. This month we will be introducing two new opportunities to donate and contribute to your community. Please stay tuned.
