Council Meeting Highlights

May 15, 2026, meeting.

Council approved the minutes of our April 19, 2026, regular meeting of council. These are available on our website. The next regular meeting will be held on Friday, June 19 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Office. The office will be closed May 22, and open from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on May 29. May 29 is the last office hour day available to pay taxes prior to the May 31 deadline for a 15% discount on the municipal portion. ETransfer's may be sent to office@mistusinne.com. There were no delegates to the meeting.

Edward Stenko presented his verbal report. The Water System is up and running for the season. The Golf Course is open. Our new Emergency Exit needs to be mowed and then is ready as needed. 30 taps have been changed so far this year. We only lost a couple of the tops of trees in the high winds this week. We are waiting on the new pads for the Boat Launch to arrive and then repairs will be made to the launch.

Tree Planting Day is May 31. The time has come to confirm volunteers. Administration will be sending around a notice this week. If you plan to attend, please reply to the email!

We are still looking for help purchasing a floor for the Gazebo. If this project interests you, please talk to a member of council or administration. Beach retaining wall blocks are available at a cost of \$500.00 each. Please contact administration if you would like to sponsor a block.

Contractors were asked to bid on our annual tree removal work. Local contractor Derek Anderson was the successful bidder. The wood removed during the tree removal project will be available to our residents at the wood pile. Please be mindful to keep these piles tidy and off the ground.

We will be hiring a part-time student to water and maintain trees for the months of July and August. If you know a student who may be interested, please apply within. More information will be emailed later this week.

Canada Day and August Long Weekend events are coming at lightning speed. Please check the new Calendar of Events on our website for all the details. "Two Amigo's" and "The Hot Dog Guy" will be treating us to quite the Fiesta Aug 2.

The Rates for 2026 were reviewed by council. Reminder that Green Space permits are required and can be applied for on our website. The space may be utilized for a maximum of 10 days.

Council approved a donation of \$250.00 to the Line 19 Health Committee towards their Rural Health Care initiatives.

Council approved the 2025 Audited Financials as presented. These will be available on our website in about one week.

Three permits were approved with conditions at this meeting. Council approved a Deck, a driveway extension, and a detached garage. Please be sure to complete a permit on our website if you intend to undertake any development this year. Please note that permits MUST be submitted no later than the Friday before the council meeting. However, earlier is better. If that permit requires adjustments this will require considerations.

Our website has undergone immense additions in preparation for the upcoming season. Please be sure to take a tour. The website will receive some cosmetic enhancements next.

Now that the new emergency gate has been installed our EMO plan will be updated to reflect.
