Water Testing

By popular request we have decided to host a well testing weekend. We will have the test bottles available for pick up on the Saturday. You will then fill the containers on Sunday morning and return them to the office during scheduled hours. We will take the samples into the lab for testing. The cost of the testing will depend on the number of participants. Those who participate will be invoiced when the results return. **This will happen July 23 & July 24**

Storage Sites:

Storage fees will be due May 31st annually. If you had a site last year, you can keep the same spot. If you do not want to keep your spot, please let the office know. If you would like to be on the waiting list please contact the office. Please send payment at your convenience. We will send invoices in 2023.

Bylaws & Policies:

Bylaws and policies are posted on the website. Contact the office if you have any questions.

Building Permits:

Submit building permits a minimum of 7 days before council meetings. If you are planning to renovate or build, please reach out to the office to receive a copy of the forms to be filled out.

House Number Reminder:

For safety reasons we require each home to properly display their civic address. Please post your cabin number if you have not already done so.

Golf Carts:

All golf carts in the village must have their cabin number on the back-right fender of the cart. Stickers have been made by the village for this purpose and can be picked up in the office. Council has worked diligently with local RCMP to come up with guidelines for golf carts and ATV use in the village.

Beach Committee:

We are looking for volunteers who would be interested in assisting with the revitalization of the beach areas. We also need assistance annually with swim platforms and the boat launch. If you are interested please contact the office.

Annual Charity Golf Tournament:

Unfortunately our trusty leader Mayor Lloyd Montgomery cannot lead the golf tournament this year. We have been unable to find a replacement and therefore we will be unable to host a tournament this year.

Base Tax Increase:

The base tax has increased to \$600 this year. The last increase was in 2013.

New Golf Rates:

Resident Adult	\$100
Resident Youth	Free (17 & under)
Non-Resident Adult	\$150
Non-Resident Youth	\$75
Daily Pass	\$15

Boat Launch:

Resident boat launch stickers are now available at the office. Each cabin is given 2 stickers at no cost. Non-residents will be charged \$30 for a season pass or \$10 per day.

E-transfer Payment:

All payments can be paid through e-transfer. This includes golf passes, boat launch, snow removal, taxes, etc. Please include what you are paying for, your cabin number and your full name in your e-transfer.

Construction Bin Cost:

The disposal fee for construction material will begin at \$60. The foreman will discuss price before disposal and the price will depend on how much material is disposed of. Please contact the office to arrange a time with the foreman.

Second Golf Cart Stickers

Have been created and are at the office for pick up. If you have a second golf cart please stop in and pick up your sticker.

Motorized vehicles on Green space

You are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles on the green space. The fine is \$250.00 if you are caught. However there is a difference between driving on the edge to avoid heavy traffic and be safe, and driving all over the place at your leisure. Please familiarize yourself with the difference and proceed

accordingly. Be mindful of your neighbours, and neighbours be please mindful of safety and mobility issues. Let's work together to have a fantastic summer.

Motorized vehicles in general

Drive VERY carefully and safely. Do not overload your ride. Do not be hanging out the sides.

SLOW Down. It is summer time. It is literally the season to stop and smell the roses.

Be cautious of those around you. Drive in appointed areas, do not cut through places you know you shouldn't, do not be a nuisance to your neighbours.

If it is your responsibility to familiarize others with the rules please do so.

We do not have a Bylaw Enforcement Officer at Mistusinne. However, the Administrator is the Bylaw officer by default. She has the authority to issue warnings and fines, and may contact the RCMP should she need assistance. She will be out Friday's, Saturday's and maybe even Sunday's all summer. Please do not put her in a situation where she has to react to situations or complaints.
