

Mistusinne Newsletter – Spring 2020

It is anticipated that there will be another newsletter in the near future to update ratepayers about postponed meetings (Annual Ratepayers Meeting), events (Canada Day, Golf Tournament & Potluck Supper, Anniversary & new boat launch dock, Off-Road Triathlon) and the Municipal Election. ALL payments can be paid by e-transfer, cheque or cash. To pay by e-transfer set up the Resort Village of Mistusinne as recipient using mistusinne@sasktel.net as the email address. In a separate email send the answer to your security question and what it is you are paying for.

The Resort Village Office will remain closed to the public for the time being, but contact can be made via email or phone to get information and forms. The Playground will remain closed until Provincial Government restrictions are lifted.

There is a new Loraas bin for recycling which will be open Fridays from 12 noon until 5 PM for the time being. Please observe the rules for what can be recycled. There is a list attached to this newsletter and the outside of the bin. Remember to flatten or break down cardboard. The depot for bottles/cans/milk jugs, etc. will remain closed until Provincial Government restrictions are lifted.

The boat launch at Mistusinne will remain closed until the water comes up. The boat launch at the marina in Elbow is under construction and is estimated to be open mid-June.

Quads are not allowed on the beach between Douglas Park and the boat launch from April 1 until October 31 each year, unless you obtain a handicap permit from the office. Quads are allowed north of the boat launch.

The Resort Village has a new dump trailer and water tank. Watch for a picture of it in the next newsletter as well. Thank you to Enbridge for their grant in helping to pay for it.

Golf Course: With the “Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan” the golf course is allowed to open May 15, 2020. HOWEVER, the Outdoor Individual Recreational Guidelines outlined in the Province’s plan must be followed. Council will be discussing this further at their May 16, 2020 meeting, but for now this will include the following “rules”:

- Groups over 10 are NOT permitted on the golf course
- Physical distancing MUST be maintained at all times; with a minimum of two meters between individuals
- Flags will remain in the hole and the cup will be elevated so the ball does not drop in the hole. Play is concluded when the ball contacts the cup. DO NOT TOUCH THE FLAG STICK.
- Don’t tee off until the people ahead of you are clear of the green
- Payments are to be made in the golf drop box outside of the Village Office, or by etransfer (see box above for info on etransfers)
- There will be NO scorecards, or pencils available
- The washroom at the Maintenance Building will be CLOSED
