Council Updates:

<u>Boat Launch</u>: Council is working closely with the supplier to find a solution to the boat launch dock. As well, they are looking at ways to expand the parking at the boat launch.

<u>Maintenance Yard</u>: Please ensure that your name and lot number is on anything that you have stored there. In the future, unmarked articles may be towed away. It is also your responsibility to mow or whipper snip around articles stored in the yard.

ALL payments can be paid by e-transfer, cheque or cash. To pay by e-transfer set up the Resort Village of Mistusinne as recipient using

mistusinne@sasktel.net as the email address. In a separate email send the answer to your security question and what it is you are paying for.

<u>Garbage</u>: Please do not leave articles or bags outside of the bins. Keeping a clean and safe garbage area relies on the goodwill of all ratepayers. If this situation cannot be kept under control, then preventative measures will have costs associated with them and we will all have to share those costs. Sarcan in Central Butte will take electronics. Compostable materials and branches can be taken to the compost pile and branch pile. Cardboard can be taken to recycling. Please push your garbage bags to the back of the bin.

<u>Events that have been cancelled this summer</u>: Canada and Family Fun Day, Annual Charity Golf Tournament and Community Potluck Supper, Annual Ratepayers Meeting. Hopefully next year will see everyone getting back together.

Council Reminders:

- Tax, Lagoon and Water payments: etransfers (see box above), cash or cheques accepted. Please remember that payments must be RECEIVED at the Resort Village Office by the discount or due date.
- Fireworks you need a permit to set off fireworks if you are not doing it on the beach. If you are on the beach, please clean up when you are done.
- Recycling staff will NOT be sorting bags left outside of the building. Please come during open hours.
- Speed limits the speed limit in the Village is 40 km per hour (this includes the boat launch road) and in the playground area it is 30 km per hour.
- Golf Carts, quads, motorcycles are not allowed on green spaces and golf carts are not allowed on the golf greens!!! Rules regarding the operation of these vehicles comes under *The All terrain Vehicle Act*, and *The Traffic Safety Act*, and are enforced by the RCMP. Theses rules include such things as the drivers of these vehicles must be at least 16 years old and hold a valid drivers license, and quad and motorcycle drivers and riders must wear helmets. FYI the RCMP fine for no helmet is \$100!
- Many of the golf course regulations due to COVID-19 are still in place; the list is still attached on the outside of the Office.
- Resident boat trailer stickers are available from the Office. Non-resident boat launch users can pay per day or purchase an annual pass. Please note that there is NO swimming or fishing allowed within 100 feet of either side of the boat launch. This is for your safety!!!
- Building permits are required for renovations and new building projects. Forms are available from the Office.
- Dogs must be on leash (this includes the golf course). When there is a beach, the area north of the boat launch has been designated as an off-leash area.
- Handicap permits for the beach are available from the Office for quads to transport people with mobility issues.
- Green space permits are available for short term use of the green space (i.e., RV's, boats, etc.).
- Tree pruning and removal please note that you must have permission to remove or prune Village trees. The provincial elm tree pruning ban is in effect until August 31.

Thank you to all the volunteers who help with watering and turning compost, watering trees, helping with the rafts, maintaining the flowers on the golf course and in the front bed, removing sand from the boat launch, whipper snipping weeds in the tree beds and anything else that may have been missed. It is greatly appreciated!!!

Message from the Golf committee: Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 we will not be able to hold our golf tournament. This is an event many of us enjoy, and we have had some wonderful times by donating to, organizing, and playing in this tournament. We have been able to donate all the proceeds to both the First Responders in Elbow and the Elbow Fire Department. This has amounted to a large sum of money, due to your generosity, and was very much appreciated by these groups.
