#### **Council Updates:**

- The Canada 150 Committee has almost completed the park. The trees have been planted, the irrigation system is in, and the pathway and bench have been installed. Still to come this spring is a sign by the bench.
- SaskPower will be installing a light at the entrance way to the Village this summer.
- Council has been working on a new "Welcome Sign" at the entrance watch for this!
- Council has been exploring options for the boat launch and swim platforms. Please see the request for members for a Beach Committee, and consider joining!
- Council has approved a lighting and fan upgrade for the Community Centre.
- Council will be hiring two summer students for 8 weeks in July and
  August. Watch for posters or call the Village Office for more information.

# **Council Reminders:**

- \* There is a provincial ban on pruning elm trees (this includes Manchurian elms) from April 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>. Please refrain from pruning elm trees during this time.
- \* There is a new construction bin policy for ratepayers doing renovations. There will be a separate bin for construction waste and you must make prior arrangements with Maintenance or the Office to have the bin open for you on the weekends. The cost will depend on the amount of the bin that you use and heavy items such as shingles will be charged extra. The bin will also accept household items and the charge for these will also be based on the amount of the bin that you use.
- \* Building permits are required to construct, erect, place, alter, repair, renovate or reconstruct any building (or deck) that is 100 square feet and over. The repair of a deck is also included in this process due to the nature of the work (ex. guards would need to be removed, possibility of some deterioration of the joists requiring replacing/repair, and even the size of the joists may require addressing, guards on both the deck and stairs need to meet current standards for both height and spindle spacing.) Permit applications are available at the Office.
- \* Trees on the green space beside or behind your property cannot be cut down by rate payers. If you feel there is a dangerous tree please contact Maintenance and they will remove the tree if necessary.
- \* Please do not walk through other people's yards to access the beach or roadways. Use the green spaces or roads.
- \* Items for sale or give-away should not be placed in the ditch for longer than two weeks.
- \* There are green space permits available for use of the space for special events.
- \* There are handicap permits available for quads to access the beach areas for people with mobility issues. There is a \$25 returnable deposit for the permits.
- \* Remember that dogs must be on leash when off your property, this includes the beach areas except for north of the boat launch which has been designated for off leash.
- \* Maintenance storage area reminders you are responsible for mowing around the article that you have stored there; only one space per cabin please; if you are moving an article for the day leave a marker in your spot to show that it is occupied.
- \* Remember that quads (unless with permit) are not allowed on the beach areas from Douglas Park to the boat launch from April 1 until October 31.
- \* Do not put hot ashes or nails or garbage in the brush pile.
- \* There is a no swimming area 100 yards on each side of boat ramp. Council hopes to install buoys in the water to mark these areas.
